Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.134 dated 16.09.2019 registered under Sections 354, 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Urban Estate, Patiala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 02.12.2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and he was admitted on bail in the light of order passed by this Court in **CRM-M-43532-2019** titled as ***Teshpreet Singh Mohi Versus State of Punjab***.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage. He further states that motorcycle has been recovered in the case.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 02.12.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
