1. This second bail petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case under Section 22 of NDPS Act 1985 lodged in FIR No. 31 dated 12.2.2019 registered at police station Sadar Sirsa.

2. The ground taken by learned counsel for the petitioner is that seized material was marginally above the commercial quantity and the petitioner has now been in custody for almost 1 year and 6 months. However the order which has been impugned is dated 26th February, 2019 whereby interim bail of the petitioner for the purpose of marriage of sister's son was declined.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that actually thereafter the petitioner had filed an application for regular bail also which was declined on 19th March 2019. Even that happened almost one

and a half years ago.

4. In these circumstances, it would be appropriate if the petitioner first move an application for bail before the trial court.

5. Consequently, the petition stands dismissed with abovesaid liberty.

6. Since the main case has been dismissed, the pending application, if any stands disposed. of.
