The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.217 dated 07.11.2019 under Sections 307, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran.

The operative part of the order dated 05.12.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the dispute is between two brothers and brother-in-law. Petitioner No.1 Neeraj Kumar is brother of the complainant, whereas it is alleged in the FIR that petitioners No.2 & 3 were accompanying him. It is further submitted that as per allegations in the FIR, a firearm was used but no one was injured. Learned counsel further submits that the possibility of falsely implicating the

petitioners on account of previous litigation between two brothers is to be seen during the investigation....”

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 05.12.2019, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Surinder Kumar, assisted by counsel for the complainant has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 05.12.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
