Prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance for directing respondents No. 1 to 3 to produce the detenue-Geeta (wife of the petitioner-Virender) before this Court as she is in the illegal custody of respondents No. 4 and 5 by appointing warrant officer.

Status report by way of affidavit of Rattan Deep Bali, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, BPTP, Faridabad, has been filed by the learned State counsel in Court today, which is taken on record.

As per the report, FIR No. 14 dated 25.01.2020 was registered under Section 365, 452, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station PS BPTP,

Faridabad, against Virpal and Ramesh (respondents No. 4 and 5). On the basis of disclosure statement of respondents No. 4 and 5, Sections 302 and 120-B IPC were added later on, wherein it has been stated that Virpal and Ramesh (respondents No. 4 and 5) hatched conspiracy with co-accused Ram Bahadur, Girnam and Bulla and committed murder of Gita. FIR was registered against respondents No. 4 and 5, father and uncle of the detenue, respectively, whereas co-accused Ram Bahadur, Girnam and Bulla are absconding.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of, as no further order are called for.
