of the petitioner is wanted in a serious case of narco-terrorism and when
the Law Enforcement Agency had gone to look for him at the house it
was found unoccupied and it was only to prevent any harm that a lock had
been put to it.

Counsel for respondent No.6 has very fairly handed over the three keys to the petitioner which has been brought by Mr. Laxmi Narayan, ASI, NIA and this Court is glad to note that this particular case has ended over on a very happy note.
