Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 104, dated 04.11.2019 under Sections 308, 341, 323, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station S.G.N., Dev Thermal Plant, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after registration of the FIR, the parties have amicably settled the dispute with the intervention of respectable persons. The petitioner is in custody since 07.11.2019 and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars. So, the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions HC Inderjit Singh, submits that the matter is still under investigation and the injury attributed to the petitioner is grievous in nature and not simple.

Learned counsel for the complainant has given concurrence to the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view the above, but without expressing any further opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is

ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
