The petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 3 to protect their life and liberty and further to restrain respondents No.4 to 6 from harassing or interfering in their married life.

On 4.12.2019, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, status report by way of affidavit of Rajesh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, District Sirsa on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today. Copy thereof has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioners. As per the reply, petitioner No.1 was produced before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sirsa wherein she has not expressed any threat from the private respondents.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the alleged threat has vanished and the petition is rendered infructuous.

Disposed off as infructuous.
