Present : Mr.Yogesh Saini, Advocate, for the petitioner.

Precisely, the allegation, as levelled in FIR No.401 dated 07.11.2019, is to the effect that 30 grams of heroin was recovered from three persons, namely, Sher Singh @ Shera, Kuldeep Kaur and Harpreet Kaur @ Rakhi. The name of the petitioner had only emerged in the confessional statement of co-accused.

On 09.12.2019, the following order was passed:-

“After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner as also the State assisted by ASI Mukhtiar Singh, this Court is of the considered opinion that let the petitioner joins investigation.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It has not been disputed by learned State counsel that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of aforesaid order. He further contended that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required in the instant case.

In view of the above, the order dated 09.12.2019, vide which the petitioner was granted interim bail, is made absolute.
