The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to take action on complaint No.1300 dated 19.03.2018 (Annexure P-1) and reminder bearing complaint No.2071 dated 03.05.2018 (Annexure P-2) given by the petitioner.

It is the case of the petitioner that his car was stolen on 24.02.2017 but later on, it was found to be parked unclaimed near the CNG Petrol Pump, Sector 44, Chandigarh. Respondent No.5-Head Constable Tejbir Singh and respondent No.6-Head Constable Kuldeep Singh also approached there but they left the spot without taking the car into police possession.

In response to the petition, Inspector Baldev Kumar, SHO,

Police Station Sector 34, U.T. Chandigarh, has filed the status report, which is taken on record. As per the said report, Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, vide letter dated 02.11.2018, appointed an inquiry officer and ordered to open a regular departmental inquiry against Head Constable Tejbir Singh. In the inquiry report dated 1.04.2019, he was not found guilty. Now, he has been transferred from Police Station Sector 34 to Security Wing, and the departmental inquiry is pending.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for.
