Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 7 and also directing them not to interfere in their peaceful married life.

On 07.12.2019, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, status report by way of affidavit of Satish Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Head Quarter Panipat on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today. As per this reply, it is mentioned that separate statements of respondent No.4 (mother of petitioner No.1) and respondent Nos.6 and 7 (parents of petitioner No.2) were recorded on 09.01.2020, wherein they stated that they have no objection to the marriage. The petitioners expressed that they do not need any protection from the police.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press this petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
