Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8, who are continuously extending threats to them.

On 06.12.2019, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, status report by way of affidavit of Balbir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today. As per this reply, it is mentioned that the statements of the private respondents were recorded, wherein they have expressed no objection to the alleged marriage between the petitioners.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petition is rendered infructuous.
