Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.174 dated 07.11.2019 under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 09.12.2019: -

“... Counsel for the petitioner has argued that as per the allegations in the FIR, 60 liters of Lahan was recovered from the open fields and no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parminder Pal, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.12.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
