Through this petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have prayed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to protect their life and liberty and also directing respondent Nos.5 to 8 not to interfere in their personal life.

On 07.12.2019, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, status report by way of affidavit of Yogesh Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police City-1, Patiala has been filed in Court today. As per this reply, it is mentioned that the petitioners are presently residing peacefully at Patiala and do not have any kind of fear. They have expressed that they do not need any protection from police of District Patiala. The reply is accompanied by the joint affidavit of the petitioners. The said affidavit is

attested by the Executive Magistrate, Patiala.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition, which is rendered infructuous.
