Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0048 dated 29.06.2019 under Sections 307, 323, 324, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Qadian, Tehsil Batala, District Gurdaspur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed by this Court on 06.12.2019: -

“... Counsel for the petitioners has argued that after registration of the FIR, the matter has been compromised between the parties and a petition i.e. CRM-M No.42767 of 2019 praying for quashing of the FIR on the basis of the compromise is pending before this Court for 24.02.2020, in which the complainant has already appeared through his counsel. It is further argued that the dispute

is an off-shoot of civil litigation between the close relations and the same has now been amicably settled...”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdish, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 06.12.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
