Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty and also directing respondent Nos.4 to 9 not to interfere in their peaceful married life.

On 07.12.2019, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, status report by way of affidavit of Satinder Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Hoshiarpur on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today. As per this reply, it is mentioned that the statements of the petitioners were recorded on 05.01.2020, wherein they stated that they are living happily as husband and wife and have no danger to their life. They expressed that they do not need any protection from the police.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition, which is rendered infructuous.
