This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioners, who were arrested on 11.11.2019 in case FIR No.175 dated 08.11.2019 under Sections 323, 341, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25, 27 of Arms Act 1959 (Section 325 IPC added later on vide DDR No.15 dated 23.11.2019), registered at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

[2]. Perusal of the FIR shows that no gun injury is imputed to the complainant-victim by either of the petitioners. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioners and the trial of the case is likely to take some time.

[3]. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioners, they are ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
