(1) The present writ petition has been filed by Amit Kumar and another *inter alia*, praying for a direction to release their salary from December, 2018 upto December, 2019. While petitioner No.1 was appointed as Dhobi, petitioner No.2 was engaged as Painter, under the Outsourcing Policy Part -2.

(2) Notice of motion in this case was issued on 07.01.2020 and in pursuance thereto, reply has been filed by Mr. Sumit Kumar, HPS, Superintendent of Police, Panipat on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 wherein it has been pleaded that sanction *qua* extension of term of the petitioners was sent to the Head Office on 15.10.2018. In this regard reference has been made to WAN message dated 13.01.2020 (R9) sent by respondent No.4 requesting respondent No.2 to get sanction for extension of 02 Dhobi and 01 Painter from the competent authority w.e.f. 05.12.2018 to 04.12.2019.

(3) On resumed hearing of the case, learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Mohinder Singh submits that final sanction for the

release of the salary has been issued and the matter has been sent to the Finance Department for its sanction and release thereof.

(4) Counsel for the respondent further submits that in these circumstances, it is expected that within two weeks the same shall be released.

(5) The present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to ensure that the needful is done within 4 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case the same is not released, the amount so sanctioned will be realizable to the petitioner with 6% interest from the date of filing of the writ petition till the date of actual payment.

(6) So ordered.
