Custody certificate of the petitioner has been filed. Same is taken on record. Be tagged at appropriate place.

Through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.67 dated 13.05.2019, registered under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Urban Estate, District Patiala, Punjab.

According to prosecution, petitioner is a scamster, who taking advantage of enormous unemployment and non-availability of Government jobs in the State of Punjab, conducting fictitious medical examination duped innocent people of their valuable money, assuring them to provide job in this High Court. Apart from this case, petitioner has been found involved in three more cases of similar nature, out of them, two are registered in Patiala and one in Chandigarh.

Heard.

According to custody certificate, petitioner is in custody for the last 04 months and 21 days. Conclusion of trial may take a sufficient long time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner any more in jail.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the fact that petitioner being a lady, the instant petition stands allowed. Consequently, petitioner Gurjinder Kaur is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of trial, if not required in any other case, on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
