After hearing both sides, the matter is disposed off with an opportunity to the Petitioner to cross-examine PW-2, namely Virender Bansal, whose attendance shall be secured by the Petitioner purely at his own risk and the prosecution side would not be obligated to help him for that purpose.

2. Further, the Petitioner shall pay adjournment costs of Rs.5,000/- with the concerned District Legal Services Authority and in case he is unable to secure attendance of PW-2 on a date to be fixed by the Ld. Court below, no further opportunity shall be granted and thereafter, the Ld. Court below shall proceed on to pronounce its final order in accordance with law.

3. Ld. Trial Court is, therefore, directed to adjourn its proceedings, pending at the present stage, for one date.
