JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

Through the instant criminal writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release him on regular parole for six weeks to meet his family members.

Petitioner is a convict in FIR No.40 dated 26.02.2014 registered under Sections 302, 307, 324, 148, 120-B IPC at Police Station Basti Bawa Khel, District Jalandhar and has been sentenced to undergo imprisonment for life, vide judgment dated 10.10.2017.

It is contended that though the case of the petitioner was forwarded but ultimately the same was rejected vide order dated 24.12.2018 (Annexure P-1) by the Deputy Commissioner,

Jalandhar.

Upon notice, reply has been filed by the State in which it is specifically mentioned that the petitioner is a gangster and belongs to Bhana Group and his family resides in a temporary accommodation. He may cause breach of peace of city if he is released on parole. He can also abscond from parole. So police authorities did not recommend the parole release case of the petitioner and the same was not approved by the Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar. It is further mentioned that the petitioner is involved in as many as six FIRs as is borne out from the reply.

Heard.

Keeping in view the antecedents of the petitioner coupled with the fact that he is a gangster and the State has every apprehension that he will abscond from the process of law, no case for grant of parole is made out.

Dismissed.
