The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the grievance of the petitioner with regard to the dispute with his neighbour, who is also cousin brother of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has filed the reply by way of affidavit of Davinder Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Phillaur,
