The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.147 dated 29.10.2019 under Sections 323, 148, 354-A and 506 IPC registered at Police Station City-2, Mansa and further added Sections 354, 379-B, 376/511 IPC vide DDR No.64 dated 30.10.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 09.12.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sham Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.12.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
