The present petition has been filed by the petitioner-Malkhan Singh *inter alia* praying for quashing of the impugned order dated 30.10.2018 (Annexure P-1), vide which, the petitioner was ordered to be transferred from Narnaul to Ambala.

The pleaded case of the petitioner was that despite the fact that the petitioner was at fag end of his service career and was left with 5 and half of months to his credit, he has been transferred in violation of the policies.

Records of the case show that on 21.11.2018, the following order was passed:-

“Notice of the applications for 19.02.2019.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is going to retire in February, 2019 and the fact that he has not been relieved so far, operation of impugned order dated 30.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) shall remain stayed.”

After notice of motion, respondents have filed the written statement of Vinod Kumar, HPS, Superintendent of Police, Mahendergarh on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. In Para-4 of the preliminary submissions of the written statement, it has been stated that the petitioner was to retire in the month of February 2019.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the respondents-State submits that no further orders are called for as the petitioner has since retired.

Accordingly, the interim order is made absolute and the writ petition is disposed of.
