The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.330 dated 11.10.2017 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, the petitioner was wrongly roped up in the FIR and there was a delay of about 01 year and 03 months in filing of the FIR. He has further submitted that even the petitioner was not named in the FIR. He has also submitted that total amount of Rs.7699/- has already been paid back to the company.

On 09.12.2019, this Court had issued notice of motion and the petitioner was granted interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer and to abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Mr. Munish Jain, Standing counsel for UT, Chandigarh has submitted that in pursuance of the order dated 09.12.2019, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is fully cooperating with the same. He has further stated that the petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the stand taken by the learned counsel for UT, Chandigarh, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 09.12.2019 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute.
