The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.77, dated 18.10.2019, registered under Sections 308, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar.

2. Heard.

3. The petitioner has remained in detention since 20/21.10.2019. Challan has already been submitted.

3. Considering the overall circumstances and the long detention undergone by the petitioner, which is well in excess of three months by now, further detention, at this stage, would not serve any purpose. Therefore, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner,

namely, Amarjit Kumar, is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
