This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.23 dated 08.11.2019 under Sections 323, 452, 506, 34 IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station City Tauru, District Nuh.

Vide order dated 12.12.2019, this Court has issued *notice of motion* and it was directed that in case the petitioners fail to co-operate with the Investigating Officer then the State will be at liberty to move an appropriate application in this regard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that all the three petitioners have joined the investigation and fully co-operated with the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Anil has stated that the all the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully co-operated with the Investigating Officer. He has specifically stated that petitioners are not required for custodial investigation.

In view of the stand taken by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.12.2019, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
