Through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.389 dated 24.09.2019, registered under Sections 21, 22, 29 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station City, Barnala, District Barnala.

According to prosecution, on 24.09.2019, co-accused Chhinda Singh was apprehended with conscious possession of 25 intoxicant injections mark ONEREX, containing 100 ml each, besides 20 strips of TRIO-SR without any permit or licence. On interrogation, he named the petitioner and one Rani. He also disclosed that he had to supply contraband to petitioner and co-accused Rani. Consequently, petitioner was arrested on 10.10.2019 and since then she is in custody.

Learned counsel contends that final report under Section

173 (2) Cr.P.C. has yet not been filed in Court. Thus, framing of charges and conclusion of trial may take a sufficient long time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner any more in jail. No recovery has to be effected from her.

On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently opposed the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner Jasvir Kaur @ Seero is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of trial, if not required in any other case, on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
