The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 9 and not to harass the petitioners and not to register any false criminal case on the complaint given by the private respondents.

On 01.12.2019, petitioner No.1-Poonam Saini got her statement recorded before ASI Sher Singh, Police Post 61, states that parents of petitioner No.1 are satisfied with the marriage and now, the petitioners are living happily.

In view of the above, no cause of action survives in the present criminal writ petition.
