Prayer in this petition is for granting permission to the petitioner to visit England.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 5.8.2019, the prayer was declined by the trial Court on the pretext that the challan has not been presented, so the Court cannot pass the appropriate orders on the application.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljit Singh has, however, submitted that now the challan stands presented on 21.8.2019.

In view of the same, the petitioner is relegated his remedy to again approach the trial Court and in case an application is moved within a period of 10 days from today, the same be decide by the trial Court within a period of 30 days, thereafter.

Considering the exigency of the petitioner and also considering the fact that the petitioner is not involved in any other case, the trial Court may upon such terms and conditions, as it may deem fit, grant permission to the petitioner to travel abroad.

The petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
