The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') for directing respondents No. 1 to 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation of FIR bearing No. 36 dated 09.02.2018 registered under Sections 323, 324 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No. 6, Ludhiana under supervision of any superior Police Officer and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner against harm at the hands of respondent No. 4.

Notice of the petition was given to the respondents No. 1 to 3.

Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Jaswinder Singh Chahal, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Industrial Area-B, Ludhiana on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 was filed in the Registry, which is taken on record.

In the reply, it has been mentioned that on investigation report under Section 173(2) of the Cr.P.C. has been filed against respondent No. 4 regarding commission of offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 326 and 506 of the IPC and charges have also been framed and the case is pending for prosecution evidence.

None has appeared for the petitioner today.

In view of the non-appearance of any one on behalf of the petitioner, the petition is dismissed in default for non-prosecution.
