The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondents No.2 to 4 to release the detenue- Parvesh Kumar by deputing a Warrant Officer as the detenue has been illegally and forcibly detained by respondents No.2 to 4.

Vide order dated 09.12.2019 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the Registry was directed to appoint a Warrant Officer to search the detenue in the Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda or at any other places as may be indicated by the petitioner and to get him released forthwith if found in illegal custody of respondents No.3 and 4.

In compliance with order dated 09.12.2019, Warrant Officer appointed by the Registry has submitted report that the petitioner was detained in Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda under order of remand to police custody passed by SDJM,

Talwandi Sabo in case FIR No.342 dated 28.10.2019 registered under Section 408 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the above referred factual position.

Since the detenue-Parvesh Kumar was found to be in legal custody, no further action is required to be taken on the present habeas corpus petition which is disposed of accordingly.
