Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.191 dated 29.06.2017 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Nakodar Sadar, Jalandhar Rural.

Vide order dated 11.12.2019, while issuing notice of motion, the petitioner was granted the concession of interim bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and is released on interim bail and he has also deposited the costs of Rs.5,000/-.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid factual position.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the order dated 11.12.2019 passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
