Present petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for violating the order dated 20.02.2017 (P-1), passed in CWP No.19437 of 2010 as well as orders dated 16.09.2019 (P-2 and P-3), passed in LPA Nos.551 and 1987 of 2017, respectively, by the Division Bench of this Court.

In response to notice of motion, issued by this Court, short reply by way of affidavit dated 12.02.2020 of the respondent has been filed. The same is taken on record.

Perusal of paragraph 5 of the affidavit clearly reveals that in terms of order dated 20.02.2017, the department has issued order dated 10.10.2017 (Annexure R-1) and the petitioner has been adjusted in Government High School Sabjimandi, Ambala Cantt. against vacancy of Drawing Teacher, vide memo dated 20.02.2018.

Para 6 of the affidavit further reveals that after taking the petitioner back in service, she had been paid her dues w.e.f. February, 2017 to October, 2017 and Certificate to that effect is appended as Annexure R-II.

Still further, para 7 of the affidavit reveals that on the basis of recommendation of the Screening Committee, petitioner has been taken over in the Government School, vide Annexure R-III.

In view of above, there is due compliance of the orders, passed by this Court. Consequently, the present petition is disposed off.
