The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 241 dated 05.03.2019 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC (Sections 120-B and 201 IPC added later on) at Police Station Chandni Bagh, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on identical allegations three separate FIRs have been registered against him. The petitioner has been granted regular bail vide order dated 23.07.2020 in FIR No. 242 dated 05.03.2019. The custody in the present case is similar to the custody in the said case and the stage of the trial is also similar. Thus, the petitioner may be granted concession of regular bail.

Learned State counsel concedes the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
