**VIVEK PURI, J.(ORAL)**

At the first instance, the petitioner was granted pre-arrest bail. During the course of trial, she had absented from proceedings and has been declared proclaimed person vide order dated 09.05.2019 (Annexure P-2).

It has been stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had surrendered in the Court on 02.10.2019 and since then she is in custody.

The reason assigned for non-appearance is her illness, though, no medical record has been produced on record. However, it may be mentioned here that the petitioner is in custody for the last about 04 months and has suffered sufficient incarceration for the lapse on her part in absenting from the proceedings.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts, the present petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

However, this order is without prejudice to any proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. or 174-A IPC that may be initiated against the petitioner and furthermore this order is subject to the condition that the petitioner shall regularly appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing.
