Present petition is for under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.101 dated 23.06.2018 under Sections 420, 506, 406, 120-B of IPC and Section 24-A of Immigration Act, 1983, registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 06.12.2018. He further contended that 04 prosecution witnesses have been examined out of 22 prosecution witnesses.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, but he submits that there are serious allegations against the accused and no case for bail is made out.

I have considered the rival submissions.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been behind the bars for one year and one month and only 04 witnesses have been examined out of 22 prosecution witnesses and that the trial of the case will take some

more time, further detention of the petitioner will not serve any useful

purpose, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Court.
