FIR No. 49 dated 01.06.2019 under Section 324/34 IPC (later on Section 326 IPC was added in the FIR) registered at Police Station Ghall Khurad, District Ferozepur has been registered on the allegations that on 31.05.2019, petitioner was roaming with a beer bottle in his hand and was accompanied by Lovepreet Singh and one unknown person. The petitioner inflicted two-three blows of beer bottle on the left side of the face of complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that earlier in the first instance, the FIR was registered under Sections 324 read with Section 34 IPC. Subsequently after a period of more than two months, the offence under Section 326 IPC has been added. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that no specific injury has been attributed to the complainant and doctor has opined that all three injuries are collectively grievous in nature.

Petitioner was arrested on 17.10.2019. The injured has already been discharged from the hospital. Investigation is complete and the challan has been presented in the Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh has stated that she does not dispute the afore stated factual position.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
