Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.14 dated 03.10.2019 under Sections 324, 506 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Dhar Kalan, District Pathankot.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 10.12.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner has caused simple injuries with a datar to complainant Labhu Din.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon a compromise dated 18.11.2019 effected between the petitioner and complainant...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdish, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.12.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
