Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted an application for the grant of State Carriage Permits on the route from Kalanaur to Gurdaspur via Narawali, Jura Chatra as well as Kalanaur to Fatehgarh via Dhianpur, Kotli but no action has been taken on the same by the competent authority i.e. the State Transport Commissioner, due to which the petitioner is suffering prejudice.

The prayer of the petitioner is for the issuance of the direction to respondent No.2 to decide the applications dated 23.02.2018 (Annexures P-3 and P-4), which the petitioner had submitted for the grant of route permits, expeditiously.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is given to respondent No.2 to pass an appropriate order on the applications dated 23.02.2018 (Annexures P-3 and P-4).

Keeping in view the prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the

case and entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim made in the applications, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the applications dated 23.02.2018 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
