By way of filing the present petition, petitioner Harpal Kaur seeks issuance of directions to State of Haryana and Director General of Police, Panchkula for fair and proper investigation in FIR No.225 dated 12.08.2017, registered under Sections 147, 148, 323, 365, 307, 120-B, 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, with Police Station Rania, District Sirsa and for transfer of investigation to some independent agency etc.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Joginder Singh, states that challan in this case has been filed against inasmuch as 13 accused including husband of the petitioner, namely Naib Singh. Charge has been framed against them. The accused have a remedy of challenging the framing of charge against them by way of filing a revision petition. They would get an opportunity to cross examine

prosecution witnesses and to lead evidence in defence. Therefore, the present petition craving for fair and proper investigation in the case and for transfer of investigation etc. has become infructuous and is dismissed accordingly.

As far as the prayer for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner and her family members, it is observed that on representation being submitted by the petitioner in that regard, respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Sirsa would look into the same and if finds that some action needs to be taken in that regard, then the needful be done as per law.
