In view of Section 6 (2)(e) of the Passport Act, 1967, the petitioner is not entitled for issuance of the passport on his application dated 23.09.2017 as he was convicted for offences under various provisions of the Indian Penal Code vide judgment dated 28.03.2016.

Thus, the petitioner wishes to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to move an appropriate application to show passport at the proper stage.
