Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.09 dated 06.01.2018, registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind, under Sections 306 and 34 IPC.

On 16.12.2019, this Court passed the following order:

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 9 dated 16.1.2018 registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC at P.S. Safidon, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that Inderjit Singh had committed suicide on 6.1.2018 and in the suicide note, he had raised finger towards his wife and in-laws family. The other accused are on bail and have been facing the trial. He further submits that name of the petitioner was not mentioned in the suicide note. Moreover, in the enquiry conducted by DSP, the petitioner was found

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innocent. He further submits that the petitioner has been summoned to face the trial on the application moved by the prosecution under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

Notice of motion for 20.2.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Court below within 10 days. On appearance he would be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Court concerned.

Copy of the order be produced on the next date of hearing.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Hari Kishan, submits that in pursuance of the order dated 16.12.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

The petitioner has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. He is now only to face the trial. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 16.12.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
