This order of mine shall dispose of CRM-M-53316-2019, filed
by petitioner-Govinda @ Rahul, and CRM-M-53320-2019, filed by
petitioner-Sanjeev Kumar @ Toni, under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of

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anticipatory bail in case FIR No.268 dated 27.11.2019, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga, under Section 336, 427, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the orders dated 13.12.2019 passed by this Court in both these petitions, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Manpreet Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation. However, the petitioners may be directed to again join the investigation as and when called upon to do so.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, both the petitions are allowed and the orders dated 13.12.2019 passed by this Court in both these petitions, granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
