This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking for quashing of FIR No. 166 dated 25.12.2018 (Annexure P/1) registered under Sections 406/498-A IPC at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala. and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom in view of the affidavit/compromise (Annexure P/2).

By order dated 9.1.2020, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial court on 23.1.2020 for getting their statement recorded regarding genuineness of the compromise.

In pursuance to the order dated 9.1.2020, a report has been received from the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barnala, wherein it has been stated that neither the complainant nor the accused appeared in the court for getting their statements recorded.

Even no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner today. Consequently, there is no ground to interfere in the instant petition.
