The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.523, dated 28.08.2019, under Sections 406, 409, 420, 477-A, 34 & 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 10, Gurugram.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties.
