The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.17 dated 24.03.2019, under Sections 342, 363, 366 of Indian Penal Code (Section 376 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Women Dabwali, District Sirsa

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner herein was taken into custody in the aforesaid FIR on 24.03.2019. It is submitted that during the pendency of these proceedings, the matter has been compromised with the complainant and a petition for quashing of the FIR has already been preferred.

At this stage, Mr. Amandeep Singh Saini, Advocate puts in

appearance on behalf of the complainant and files the power of attorney, which is taken on record and admits to the factum of the compromise and pleaded no objection to the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Per contra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since, the trial is likely to take some time and in view of the facts that the petitioner herein has been in custody since 24.03.2019 and that the matter stands compromised, no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind bars. At this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

However, anything observed or said by this court is only for the purpose of deciding the instant petition for grant of regular bail and the same shall have no affect on the merits of the case.
