The instant petition was filed at the hands of 30 Safai Sewaks working under Nagar Panchayat, Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda on outsourcing basis seeking a Mandamus directing the respondent/concerned authority to treat them as regular employees under the Punjab Ad hoc, Contractual, Daily Wage, Temporary, Work Charged and Outsourced Employees' Welfare Act, 2016 (for short the 2016 Act).

Petition had come up for preliminary hearing before this Court on 1.2.2019 and the following order was passed:-

“Counsel for the petitioners seeks time to place on record documents/material to reflect the eligibility of each one of the petitioners to claim benefit under Section 6 of the Punjab Ad hoc, Contractual, Daily Wage, Temporary, Work Charged and Outsourced Employees' Welfare Act, 2016.

List on 08.04.2019.”

In pursuance to the order dated 1.2.2019 no documents/material has been placed on record to demonstrate the eligibility of each of the petitioners to claim benefit under the 2016 Act.

Counsel representing the petitioners concedes during the course of hearing today that some of the petitioners would not be eligible to claim

benefit under the provisions of the 2016 Act. He accordingly prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to file a petition afresh at the hands of such petitioners who fulfill the eligibility parameters under the 2016 Act.

Prayer is allowed.

Petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.
