Petitioner has filed this third petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.420 dated 16.12.2010, under Sections 419, 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Tosham, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was earlier declared proclaimed offender on 18.08.2011 and was arrested on 14.08.2018. The petitioner had been involved in the present case on the basis of disclosure statement of one Mahabir Singh, who has been acquitted of the charges.

On the other hand, learned State counsel after seeking instructions from ASI Om Parkash, opposes the prayer made in the present petition, and states that out of 24 prosecution witnesses, none has been examined.

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I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned State counsel.

Challan has already been presented in the present case. The petitioner has been in custody since 14.08.2018, as stated. The trial of the case would take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
