The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.217 dated 07.11.2019 under Sections 307, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran.

The operative part of the order dated 18.12.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Contends that petitioner is the brother-in-law of Neeraj Kumar and the allegation qua him is that he has supported said Neeraj Kumar regarding some property dispute against the complainant. Further contends that three of the co-accused, namely, Neeraj Kumar, Rajesh Kumar Sabharwal and Nitish Kumar @ Goltu have been granted interim protection by Coordinate Bench of this Court, in CRM M-51633 of 2019....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance

to the order dated 18.12.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Surinder Kumar, assisted by counsel for the complainant has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 18.12.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
