Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail, pending trial in complaint bearing No.NDPS/100/2018 titled as Intelligence Officer Versus Gurjeet Singh and another”filed under Sections 8, 21, 23, 29, 60 and 61 N.D.P.S.Act, 1985. The petitioner is in custody since his arrest on 23.09.2017.

As per the complaint, on 23.09.2017, an information was received by the Intelligence officer, NCB, Amritsar from 87 Bn.BSF, Amarkot, Tarn Taran that they recovered some suspected heroin from the possession of two persons, namely, Nirmal Singh and his son Gurjeet Singh in the area of responsibility of BSF Border Out Post, Karma and the BSF wanted to hand over the same to NCB, Amritsar for further legal proceedings as per law. On the basis of the said information, a team was constituted for taking necessary action as per law. On 23.09.2017 the

investigating team arrested the petitioner and 3 kgs.570 grams heroin was recovered from his possession.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent, on instructions from Pravin Kunderia, Intelligence Officer, states that only one witness remains to be examined and the case is fixed on 16.11.2020 before the trial Court for recording the evidence.

Considering the stage of the trial, no case is made out for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed.
